Best Prawning times

4-5 days either side of the New Moon.

On the run out tide about 2 hours before low tide

Welcome by-Catch

Blue swimmer Crabs

Squid

Sustainable fishing practices

Please return all by-catch to the alive. Do not leave blowfish (toadfish) and jellyfish on the foreshore.

Consider releasing berried and small prawns

Please take your rubbish home with you.

Abide by fishing regulations set by the Department of Fisheries. Check before you net.
